IV. INFORMATION ITEMS:

3. California Voting Rights Act Update: The Board received the following information regarding the status of CVRA action in Lincoln, Linden, Lodi, and Ripon unified school districts:

Lincoln Unified School District – the Board has submitted a general waiver request to the State Board of Education (SBE) and awaits a decision.

Linden Unified School District – the Board will consider approval of a map depicting the rearrangement of trustee areas of choice and an alternate method of election at their October 16, 2013 meeting. Following that action the Board will consider approving the submission of a general waiver to the SBE at the next succeeding meeting.

Lodi Unified School District – the Board has approved a map and selected to change to a by-area method of election. The Board submitted a waiver request to the SBE and it has been approved. As the demographer finalized the map, it was discovered that the boundary split a parcel, which tweaked the map. The Board will be asked to put a final stamp of approval on the map at the November 5, 2013 regular meeting. This item will return to the County Committee for approval at the November 20, 2013 meeting.

Ripon Unified School District – the waiver that was first submitted to the SBE was returned as incomplete. It was requested that the waiver indicate the status of the bargaining units and community groups in the Ripon Unified School District. Both the bargaining units, CSEA and RTA, indicated a neutral position. The community groups' opinion was not available at the agenda deadline but further information should be obtained by the meeting.
